Joe Still - Mr. Still agrees with Ms. Holbrook's comment.

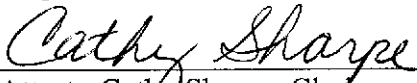
Sharon Still - Ms. Still thanks everyone for their hard work. She said she is glad to have and maintain a budget.

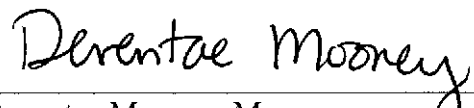
Deventae Mooney - Mr. Mooney had no comments or concerns.
